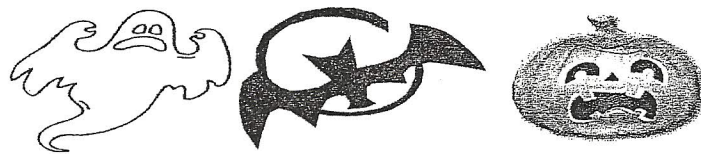

**No weapons, brooms, hatchets, pitch forks, wands or other hand held props are allowed with the children.**



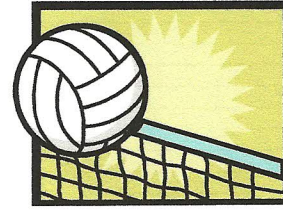
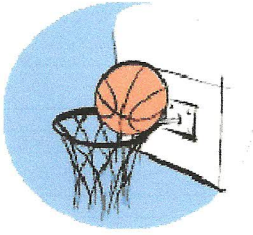
