## Registration for 2022-23:

Friday is the last day for the \$100 registration fee. It goes up to \$150 after Friday.

**Spots are limited.** Secure your spot by registering this week. You can guarantee keeping your seat at the school, if you register sooner. Registering later risks loss of your spot for the 2022-23 School Year.

There are three steps to registration: 1.) Pay the registration fee; 2.) Complete and sign the tuition contract and 3.) Set up a FACTS account.

Upon completing these registration steps, students will receive a free t-shirt that can be worn with jeans on all Fridays, until the end of the school year!

## Mask Mandate:

The Archdiocese of Chicago has laid out the following guidelines for COVID-19 mitigation when the mask mandate comes to an end on 2/28.

**What counts as close contact?** If one is wearing a mask, within 3 ft. of a person for a duration longer than 15 minutes. If one **is not** wearing a mask, within 6 ft. of a person for a duration longer than 15 minutes.

**What happens if someone tests positive?** Irrespective of one's vaccination status, one will need to quarantine for five days. For days 6-10, students will need to wear a mask at all times.

**What happens if one is in close contact with someone who tested positive?** If one is vaccinated and symptom free, then no quarantine is required. If one is un-vaccinated, then a five day quarantine is required whether one is symptomatic or symptom free. The only exception is if the unvaccinated, symptom free person does a rapid test each of the five days. A negative result is required to gain admittance to the school each of the five days. Regardless of vaccination status, a close contact will need to wear a mask for 10 days after the close contact.
